CREATIVE WRITING II

Class Description: This course will focus on a group of specific techniques for shaping and informing your writing, including voice, tone, and point of view; use of tense; and use of detail. Through analysis and discussion of sample texts and numerous in-class exercises, we will work toward achieving vivid precision and the creation of engaging narratives, fiction or non-fiction. Each session will focus on a different tool or group of related tools; come prepared to read, write, and discuss. **This class explores adult themes, language, and content.**

Class Goal: Students should come away from this class possessing a greater knowledge of the theory and mechanics behind their art, have more confidence that their writing matches their intentions, and have more enthusiasm for writing by possessing better skills in its creation and editing.
